

Song of Solomon – Part 19

Song 8:1

–This becomes the bridal soul’s heart-cry upon entering into the harvest field.

■ *In the culture of this day, public displays of affection were unacceptable.*

■ *Even, now, laboring in the harvest, the desire is for relationship.*

■ “Let me show my love for You to outsiders.”

■ *As the soul has entered into this oneness and maturity, they want everyone to experience this!*

Song of Solomon – Part 19

Song 8:2

–The bridal soul longs to release and impart the same experience of the Bridegroom to all believers and non-believers.

■ *The same deliverance from self that results in oneness and intimacy with Him.*

■ *But, to see this deliverance and maturity happen, they have to be weaned off milk and introduced to strong food and drink.*

Song of Solomon – Part 19

Song 8:3-5

–Pro. 3:5: “Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding.”

■ *There is no trust in self, education, worldly wisdom, the fallen opinions of others, etc.*

■ *There is only the mind of Christ to be heeded, whether it comes directly from the Spirit, or is heard/discerned through others or circumstances.*

Song of Solomon – Part 19

Song 8:6

–Let My Spirit be the “seal” over your affections, desires and actions.

■ *Your one response/motivation is My desire for you that governs your thoughts, emotions, words and actions.*

■ *“Let My Spirit have Lordship over your heart.”*

■ *What was a loose, undisciplined mob has now become an army.*

■ *Because they embraced the fellowship of His sufferings (sacrificial death to self out of love for Him), they have now become ONE with Him and all-consuming love.*

Song of Solomon – Part 19

Song 8:7

–No trial or test can quench this all-consuming passion - nothing can separate.

■ **Rom. 8:38-39:** *“For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.”*

Song of Solomon – Part 19

Song 8:8-9

–What about the lost and immature?

■ *There is still a “younger sister” approaching marriage age, what shall be done to bring this one to maturity?*

■ *It won’t be done by building “fence laws” to protect this one from the world.*

■ *These same rules keep the Bridegroom out and keep the maturing bride from oneness.*

■ *They must come via the same process.*

Song of Solomon – Part 19

Song 8:10-11

–My life is not a barrier to keep others out, but a haven to house His glory so that others may find Him.

■ *My life is now able to both satisfy Him and feed His flock at the same time.*

–All the while, He waits patiently for the harvest fruit.

■ *“Baal-hamon” means, “lord of a multitude”.*

■ *Just as in the parable of the talents, the bridal-servants have multiplied the “money” (redemptive gifts and empowerments) that He “loaned” them.*

Song of Solomon – Part 19

Song 8:12-14

–The soul bears fruit to Him, by raising up others in His likeness, who, in turn, care for others (multiplication and harvest).

–Rev. 22:17: “And the Spirit and the bride say, ‘Come!’”

■ *The bride and the Spirit are now one.*

■ *This is a bride without spot or wrinkle.*

■ *This is the signal for His return to get His Bride and rule and reign, bodily on the earth.*
